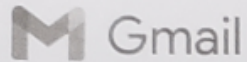

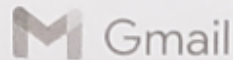

Subject: Request for Clarification Regarding Inspection and Alleged Violations

Dear Paul Lovato,

I am writing to request clarification regarding the inspection notice I received on March 21st, 2023, and the alleged violations associated with it. The violation mentioned in the letter, building code B59:8.100.190, states that work has been done without the benefit of a permit. However, I would like to clarify that no work has been done on the property that would require a permit.

After emailing you on April 4th, you disclosed that a complaint had been filed against the property regarding an alleged addition to the garage being built and a wood chipper being used. I would like to emphasize that there is no such addition being built and there has been no use of a wood chipper on the property. The sound mentioned in the complaint was most likely generated by a wood planer being used to fix a fence that was blown down in one of our many recent storms. The water sounds mentioned were also most likely from pumping out water that had flooded areas of the property.

Another notice was received and like the others, this again lacks any information pertaining to what specific structure or building this is all about. Neither notice provided has any information or clues as to what this infraction is concerning. I would request that in accordance with these alleged violations, specifics be provided clarifying what wrongs have been violated pertaining to the two vague infractions noted in the provided Correction List.

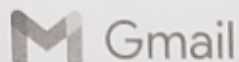
Access to the backyard can be arranged so that you can verify that the information provided is true. Chapter 8.100.210 clearly states that "all construction or work for which a permit is required shall be subject to an inspection". Because no construction or work has been done on the property that would require a permit, access to the interior is unjustified. As a matter of privacy and property rights, I would like to respectfully decline access to the interior of the property's detached garage.

I hope that access to the backyard will be sufficient to verify that the allegations in the complaint are false. Please let me know if you require any further information. Photos of the damage and minor repairs could be provided if requested.

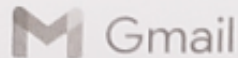

Thursday after 2 pm (27th)

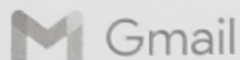
